

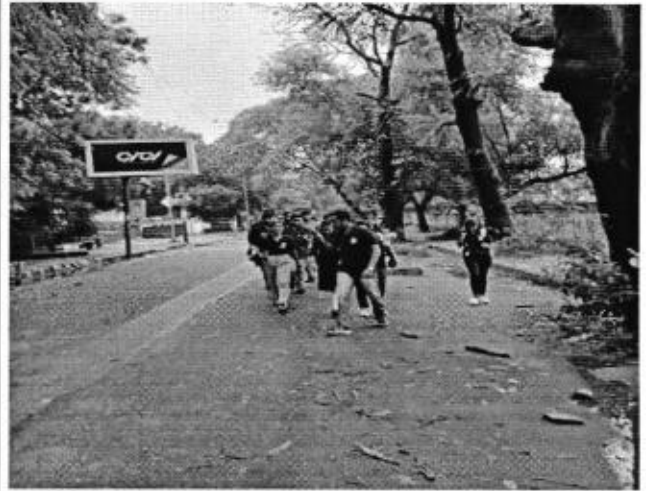

On International Peace Day, the NSS (National Service Scheme) organized a comprehensive outreach activity under the theme "Promoting Peace, Spreading Happiness & Building Futures." The day began with an **interactive session** on the significance of **International Peace Day**, exploring its roots in the **United Nations' efforts** to encourage global peace and ceasefire. Participants learned about the historical context of the day and the broader implications of peace in achieving the **United Nations' Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)**, particularly goals related to **peace, justice, and strong institutions**. The session highlighted how peace acts as a key enabler for development, equality, and happiness in societies.

Following this, participants engaged in a **conflict resolution workshop**, where they explored practical strategies for addressing conflicts in their personal lives, schools, workplaces, and communities. The workshop included role-playing activities where participants practiced **mediation techniques, active listening, and empathetic communication**—all essential tools for diffusing tensions and promoting peaceful solutions. Through these exercises, participants gained hands-on experience in handling real-life conflicts and learned how to foster constructive dialogue even in challenging situations.

A central part of the activity was the **Peace March**, where students, volunteers, and community members took to the streets with banners and placards advocating for peace and unity. The march aimed to raise awareness among the local population about the importance of peace in building a harmonious society. Along the route, volunteers distributed **peace pamphlets** that contained information about how every individual can contribute to a peaceful community, offering practical advice on resolving disagreements, promoting tolerance, and understanding cultural differences.

The outreach also included a **panel discussion** on the theme "**Peace and Happiness: Building Stronger Futures.**" The discussion featured community leaders, educators, and youth advocates who spoke about the strong relationship between peace and happiness.
