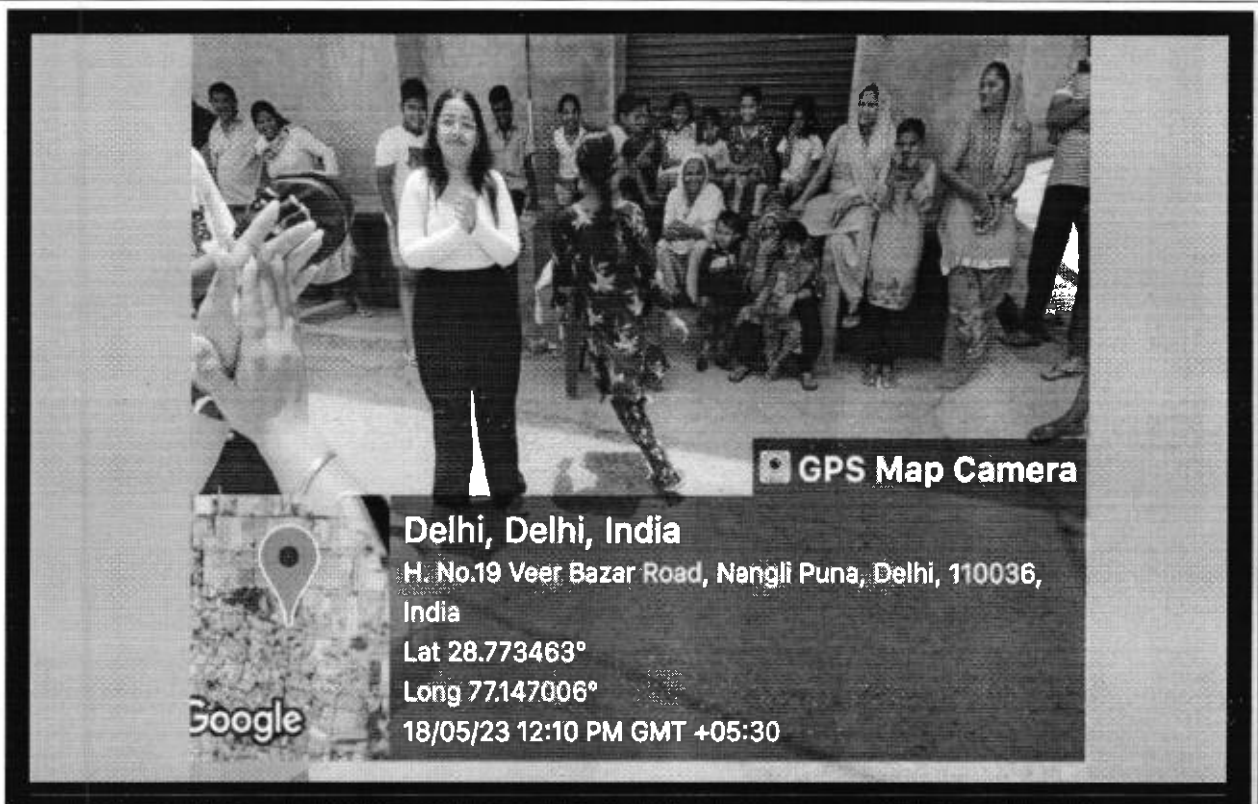



Detailed Report

The street play "*Breaking the Chains*" aimed to raise awareness about the deep-rooted societal issue of *Dahej Pratha* (the dowry system) and to promote a collective stance against this harmful tradition.

Through compelling performances, the participants sought to educate the audience about the consequences of dowry and encourage communities to break free from this practice. The session was held as part of a community outreach initiative to raise awareness about the deeply ingrained social evil of dowry, which continues to impact women's lives in many regions. The street play aimed to communicate the negative consequences of dowry through a powerful medium of performance, emphasizing the need for collective action to eradicate this practice. The event commenced at 2:00 p.m. with a warm welcome to the audience.
