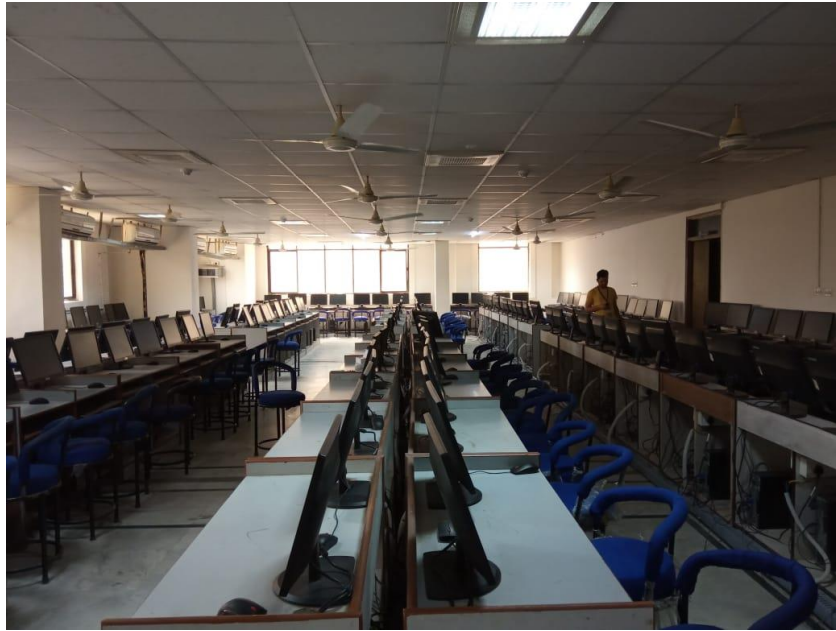

The Institute boasts a modern, air-conditioned Computer Centre featuring wireless connectivity (Wi-Fi). Our computing facilities include five fully equipped computer labs supported by a team of highly qualified IT faculty, designed to meet the academic needs of aspiring professionals entering the industry. The center is outfitted with numerous branded computers featuring LCD monitors and robust IBM Xeon servers. Each lab is equipped with an LCD projector and screen.

We operate a local area network (LAN) under a Client-Server architecture using Windows Server. Students have access to a variety of platforms, including Unix, Linux, and Windows, with software such as IBM Rational Rose, SPSS 17.0, SQL Server 2010, Visual Studio 2010, Codegear C++, Builder 2009, Microsoft Office 2010, Adobe Dreamweaver 8.0, Adobe Flash Pro, Adobe PageMaker 7.0, the Adobe Video Bundle, Corel Draw, Oracle 11g, Adobe InDesign, Photoshop CS4, Quark Xpress, and Final Cut Pro/Studio, all protected by Microsoft Essential Antivirus. The Centre also offers a range of business and management software for Quantitative Analysis and Multi-Dimensional Scaling. Students can utilize dedicated Multimedia Systems equipped with animation software, supported by high-speed printers, DVD writers, webcams, scanners, and other peripherals. The facility is connected to a 24-hour dedicated 16 Mbps leased line for high-speed internet access. Our interactive website, www.tiaspg.tecnia.in, includes the TECNIA Portal for resource sharing among students. Each student is provided with an individual login and email facility through a common URL.

All labs are equipped with 24-hour power backup through UPS and DG sets, and the entire campus benefits from secure internet connectivity, filtered by a firewall accommodating up to 2,000 users.

The major activities undertaken by the Centre are the production and dissemination of educational audio-video programmes. It serves as a Nodal Resource Centre in production, dissemination of promotional educational and training programs software's for the entire Tecnia Group, utilizing a wide range of communication media. Curriculum-based audio-video programmes are developed to supplement the courseware of GGSIPU by a trained and skilled in-house faculty , using state-of-the-art facilities which helps student to prepare a video brief, handle various aspects of TV production and direction, use of sound and light, application of production and post-production technique effectively to produce a video program. Further, the students develops the competency to handle video camera, compose shots, shoot appropriate visuals for video prgrammes, use lights effectively inside and outside the studio, use audio equipment appropriately, produce a video programme. Students should be able to use different types of microphones for radio /audio productions, record and edit radio programs of different formats, produce radio interviews, discussions, features and documentaries, cover events outside the studios. In addition, freelance filmmakers have been empanelled and suitable programmes are also sourced from agencies such as P7, Delhi AajTak, CNEB, MH-1, A to Z etc. Non-broadcast modes of delivery are adopted.

Audio Studio of Tecnia Media Production Studio is designed to enhance capabilities of audio production. Audio lab is equipped with multi facilities audio lab with console panel along with modern sound editing software such as sound forge 9, cool edit pro.

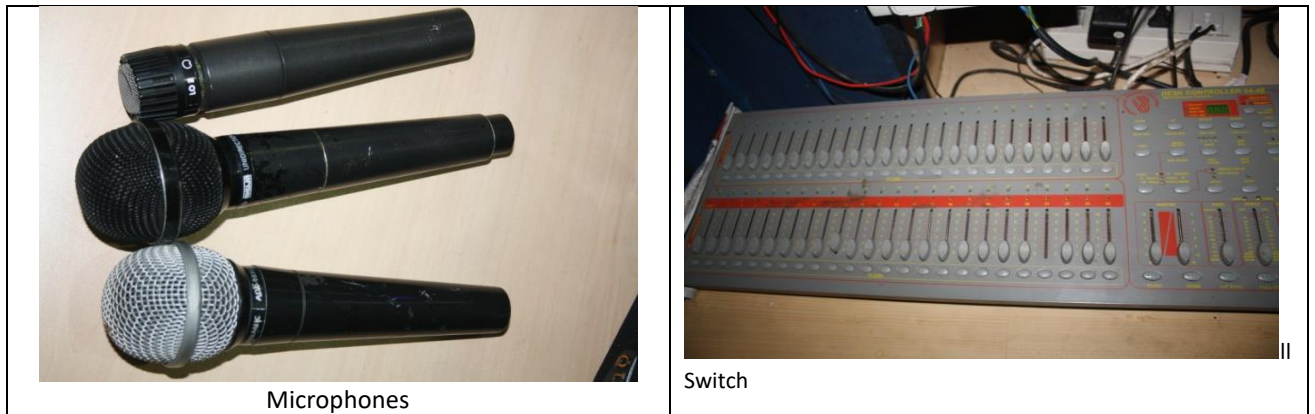

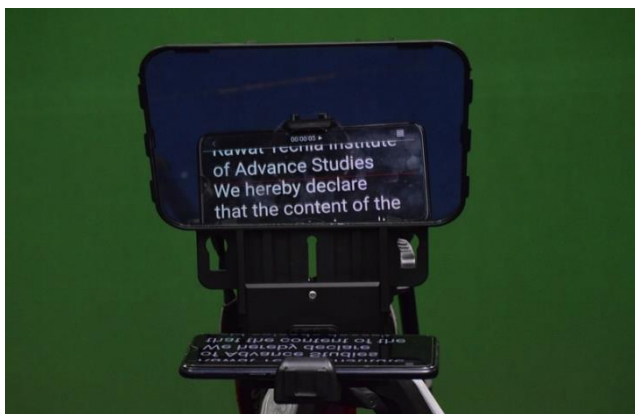
BROADCAST TELEPROMPTER

A Teleprompter refers **to the device used to give presenters visual access to the text they need to speak**. Also called an Autocue, a Teleprompter allows the reader to keep eye contact with their audience while sounding impromptu. To date, production teams use Teleprompters in videography and live speeches.



The camera lens centred on the back of the teleprompter glass/hood and as close to the glass as possible, without touching. Centring the lens on the glass vertically can be achieved by adjusting the height of the hood up or down as required.

Language Lab



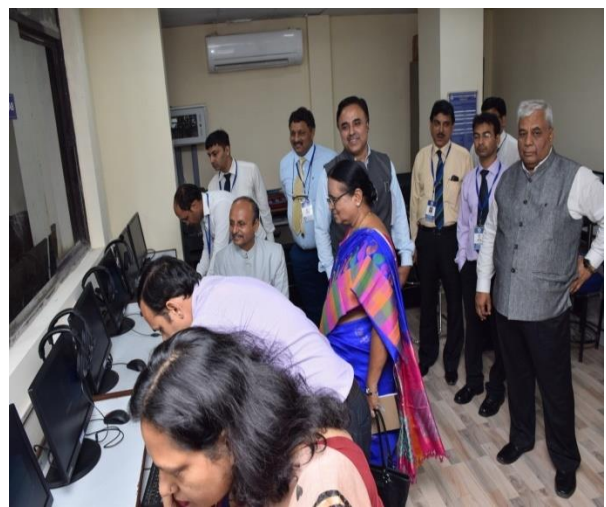
