Report of the Session: Research is the methodical, unbiased process of obtaining, logging, and analysing data in order to make appropriate and significant conclusions. Management decision-making is facilitated and uncertainty is decreased by applied research. One needs to be well-versed in the most recent advancements in research methods to keep up with recent advancements in any area. The Workshop on Research Methodology & Data Analysis will explore the fundamental aspects of research and the consequent need for participants to rethink the assumptions that underlie historical paradigms of research in the field of management while keeping in mind the significance of research methodology. The goal of the course is to give participants a practical way to do research.
