- Better understanding of media ethics and responsibility in discourse.

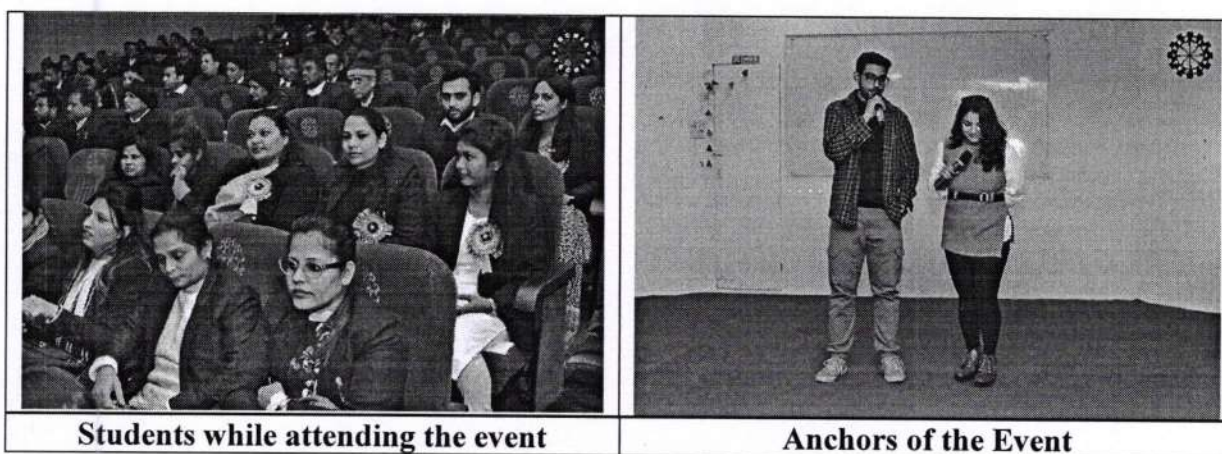
