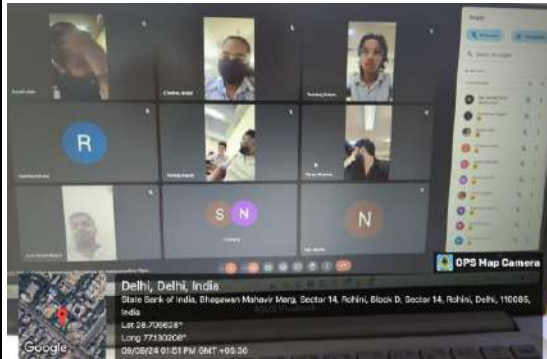

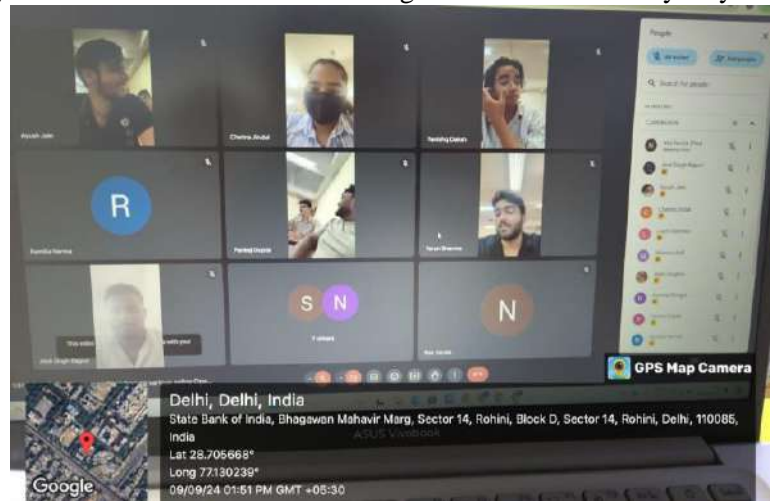




Students Celebrating International Literacy Day
