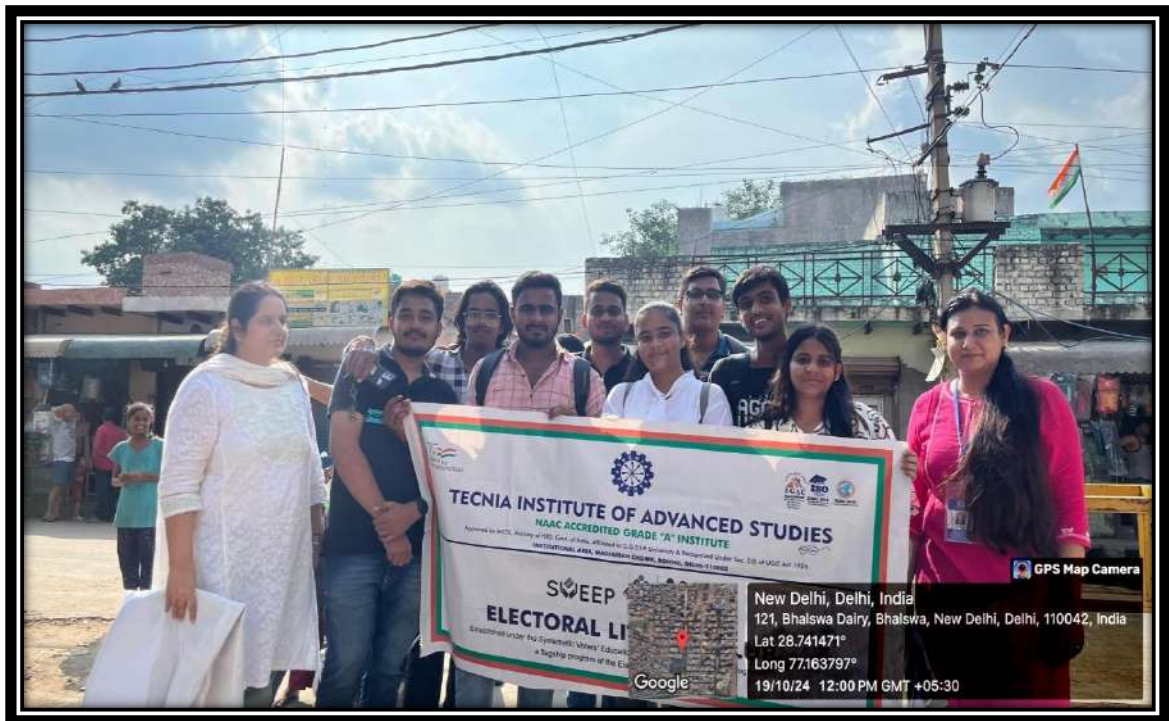

The Electoral Literacy Club of Tecnia Institute of Advanced Studies in collaboration with the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA Cell), organized an Outreach Program on Empowering Democracy with the theme "Enhancing Citizen Services for National Advancement", focusing on the E-EPIC – Digital Voter ID initiative.
