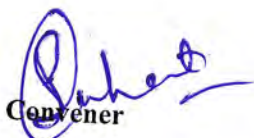
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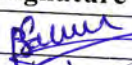
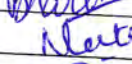
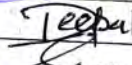
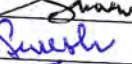
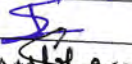
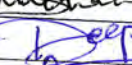
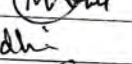
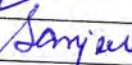
1. Establish institutional IPR cells to support researchers in patent filing and legal procedures.

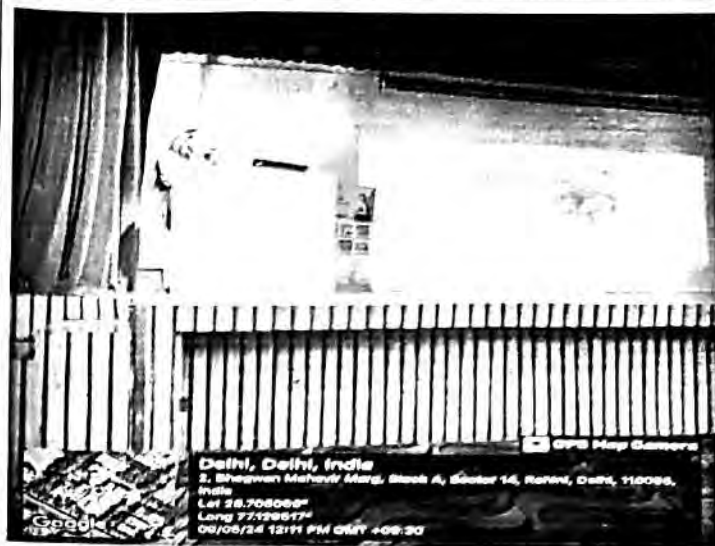
