- **Faculty:** 87% achieved greater personal-professional clarity, and 75% reported lower stress and better emotional stability.
- **Institutions:** Observed improved discipline, teacher-student rapport, and alignment with NEP 2020's holistic education goals.

*The study confirms UHV as an effective, scalable model for fostering well-being, ethical behavior, and academic sincerity in technical education.*

# ANNEXURE – I

## *Consolidated Evidence of Impact of Universal Human Values (UHV) in Indian Higher Technical Education*

**(Based on IRMA National Impact Study, 2022–2024)**

Since 2017, the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) has introduced Universal Human Values (UHV) across higher technical institutions through the Student Induction Programme (SIP), Faculty Development Programmes (FDPs), and curriculum-level integration. The **IRMA National Impact Study (2022–2024)** provides independent and comprehensive evidence of UHV’s measurable impact on students, faculty, and institutions across India.

### **1. National-Level Assessment (IRMA – Institute of Rural Management Anand)**

A three-phase independent study by IRMA assessed the outcomes of UHV across Indian higher educational institutions.

#### **Coverage**

- **27,036 faculty members** oriented through 3–8 day full-time FDPs
- **11,000 students** exposed to UHV through SIP/UHV courses
- **5,325 institutions** sampled across **34 states/UTs**
- Multi-disciplinary and multi-regional representation

#### **Key Outcomes – Students**

- **71%** reported improved family and peer relationships
- **65%** experienced reduced anxiety and academic stress
- **68%** gained greater clarity of purpose and confidence
- Significant improvements observed in:
  - Academic sincerity
  - Class attendance and participation
  - Time management
  - Creativity and teamwork

#### **Student Reflection:**

“Earlier I studied for marks. Now I study with clarity and confidence.” – *Student, AKGEC*

#### **Key Outcomes – Faculty**

- **87%** reported greater clarity in personal and professional life
- **75%** experienced reduced stress and improved emotional stability
- Enhanced:
  - Mentoring abilities
  - Classroom engagement
  - Student–teacher relationships

UHV has emerged as a **proven, scalable, and impactful** foundation for value-based education in India.
