





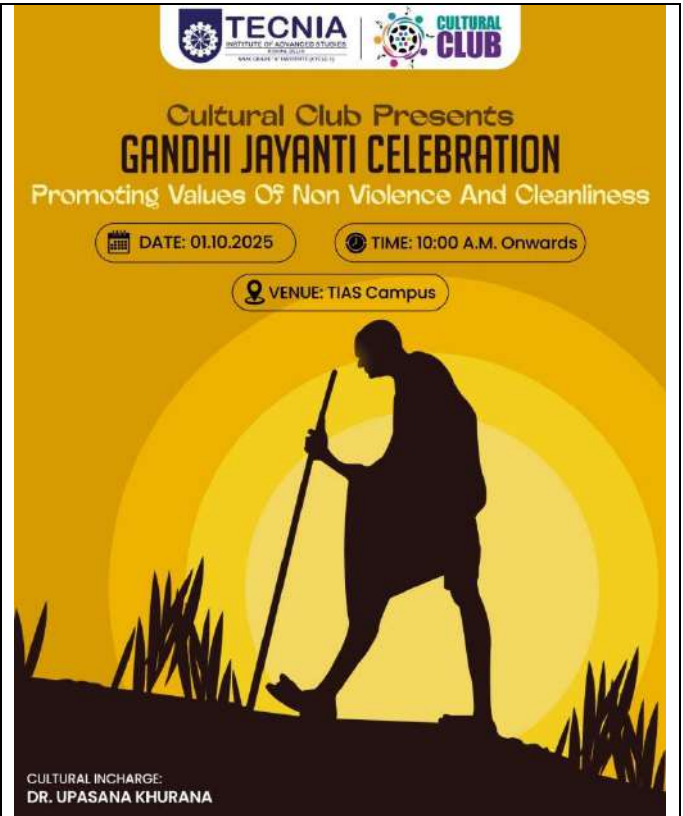



<p>Report: Description in (min 250 to max 800 words)*</p>	<p>The Cultural Club, in collaboration with NCC and NSS Club, organized Gandhi Jayanti Celebration on 1st October, 2025 to commemorate the birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi and to promote his timeless values of non-violence, truth, and cleanliness. The program was designed as an awareness and outreach activity aimed at nurturing social responsibility and civic sense among students.</p> <p>The celebration commenced with an essay writing competition, where students articulated their thoughts on Gandhian philosophy, non-violence, and the relevance of Mahatma Gandhi’s ideals in modern society.
