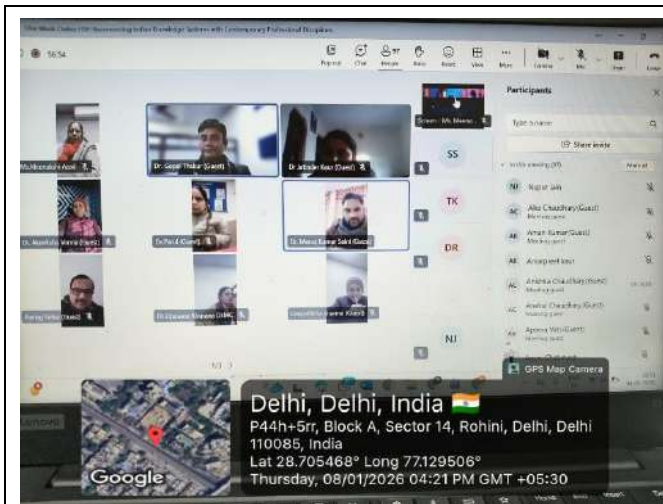

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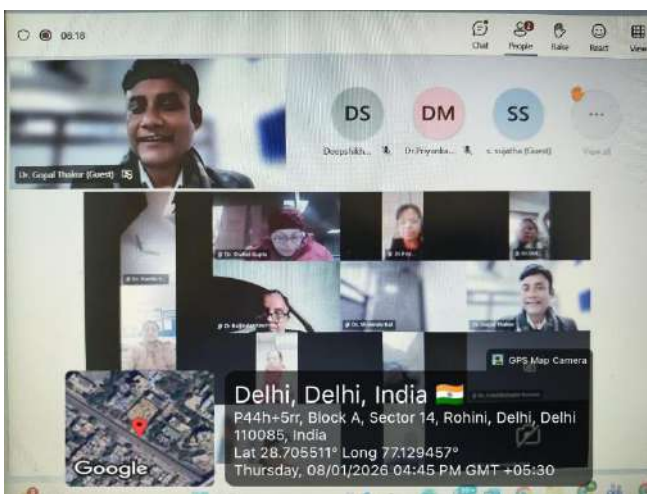

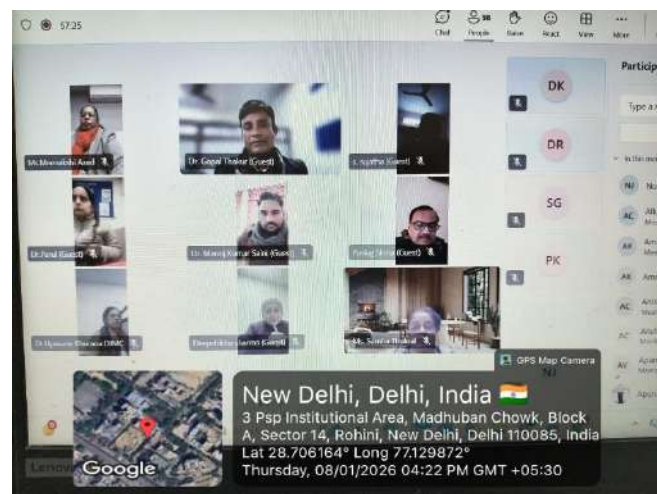

The FDP was conceptualized in alignment with the objectives of **NEP 2020**, focusing on the integration of Indian Knowledge Systems into

higher education, research, and professional practices.


