

Report: Description in (min 250 to max 800 words)*	<p>On the occasion of World Human Rights Day, observed annually on 10 December to commemorate the adoption of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights by the United Nations in 1948, the Department of Journalism and Mass Communication organized a Nukkad Natak (street play) within the university campus. The activity aimed to create awareness about fundamental human rights and encourage active civic participation among youth.</p> <p>The theme of the street play, “Know Your Rights, Stand for Justice,” focused on key issues such as gender discrimination, child labor, freedom of speech, right to education, and equality before law. Students creatively depicted real-life situations where individuals face injustice and demonstrated how awareness and collective action can bring positive change. The performance used impactful dialogues, slogans, and songs to engage the audience and deliver strong social messages.</p> <p>The Nukkad Natak format proved to be highly effective as it encouraged spontaneous interaction with the audience. Many students and faculty members gathered to witness the performance and appreciated the efforts of the participants. The event emphasized that human rights are universal, inalienable, and applicable to all individuals regardless of caste, gender, religion, or economic background.</p> <p>The program also helped students enhance their creativity, teamwork, stage presence, and public speaking skills. It reinforced the importance of empathy, equality, and social responsibility among youth. Overall, the activity was successful in spreading awareness and fostering a spirit of justice, equality, and respect for human rights in alignment with global and constitutional values.</p>


