

The initiative aimed to promote awareness about digital electoral services and encourage citizens to adopt technology-driven democratic practices.</p> <p>The event focused on introducing residents to the concept of the Electronic Electoral Photo Identity Card (E-EPIC), a</p>

The session began with an interactive discussion on how digital innovations are transforming governance and enhancing citizen participation in democratic processes.</p> <p>Participants were guided on the purpose and advantages of E-EPIC, including ease of access, portability, reduced dependency on physical documents, and increased efficiency during electoral processes. The outreach team explained how E-EPIC supports inclusiveness by enabling voters to securely store and access their identity through digital platforms.</p> <p>Students and volunteers conducted live demonstrations and step-by-step explanations, addressing common concerns related to digital literacy, data security, and authentication. Community members actively interacted with the team, seeking clarifications on downloading, accessing, and using E-EPIC for electoral purposes. The hands-on approach helped build confidence and familiarity with digital electoral tools. Dr. Parul Gaba, Nodal Officer of the Electoral Literacy Club, emphasized the importance of embracing digital solutions as responsible citizens in a rapidly evolving democracy. She highlighted that informed usage of electoral services strengthens transparency, efficiency, and trust in democratic institutions. The initiative successfully bridged the gap between citizens and digital electoral services, reinforcing the idea that democracy flourishes when participation is both informed and accessible. By combining awareness with practical guidance, the program contributed meaningfully to empowering citizens and promoting inclusive democratic engagement at the grassroots level.</p> <p>Overall, the outreach initiative proved to be impactful in advancing digital literacy, civic responsibility, and democratic participation, aligning with the national vision of a technologically empowered and participative democracy.</p>
