

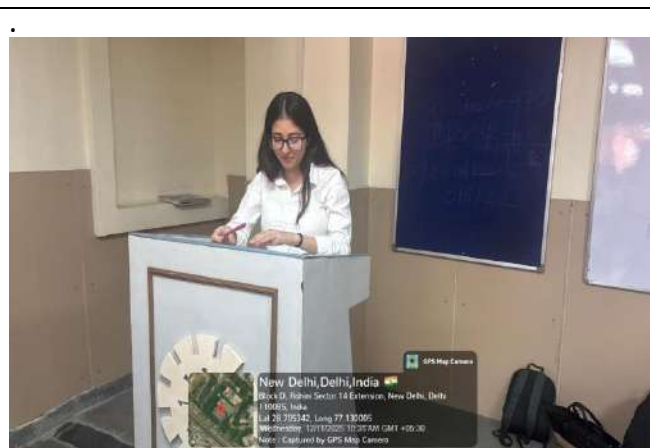



The Electoral Literacy Club of Tecnia Institute of Advanced Studies organized a Poetry Slam titled “The Pulse of Democracy: Civic Duty in Verse” on 12th November, 2025. The performances were acknowledged for their originality, message clarity, relevance to the theme, and emotional impact. The event successfully created an interactive and reflective environment where students connected democratic principles with personal responsibility. It reinforced the message that voting is both a right and a duty and that informed citizens play a crucial role in strengthening democratic institutions.</p> <p>Overall, the Poetry Slam proved to be a meaningful initiative that effectively combined artistic expression with civic education.
