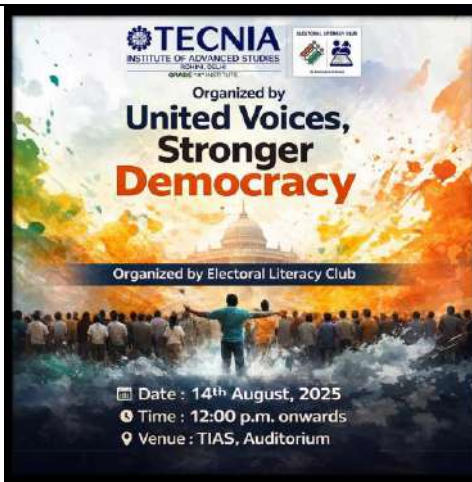

The event aimed to reinforce the significance of electoral participation and inspire the youth to uphold the constitutional values of democracy and integrity. The session commenced with a brief introduction on the historical and constitutional foundation of the right to vote, highlighting its critical role in building a strong and inclusive democracy. Faculty members addressed the gathering and emphasized how each vote contributes to societal transformation and national progress. The discussions centered on ethical voting</p>
	<p>practices, transparency in elections, and the duty of every citizen to participate responsibly. Students actively engaged in thought-provoking conversations about the importance of voting. They shared their views on youth involvement in democratic processes, the role of electoral awareness, and how making informed choices can shape the future of governance. Real-life examples were cited to stress the impact of voter apathy and the importance of inclusive participation. A key highlight of the event was the Voter's Pledge, taken by all participants with enthusiasm and sincerity. The pledge focused on voting with integrity, resisting undue influence, and encouraging others to exercise their democratic rights. This symbolic act reinforced their sense of civic duty and individual accountability. The event concluded with a shared commitment to uphold the principles enshrined in the Constitution and to spread awareness about free and fair elections. It successfully instilled a strong sense of civic pride and responsibility among students, motivating them to become active, informed, and ethical contributors to the nation's democratic fabric.</p>
