AND

Sanskriti Youth Foundation, registered name Sanskriti Welfare Society, 20, Lokendra Puri, near Pratap Nagar, Agra, Uttar Pradesh-282010, the Second Party, and represented herein by its Deepak Tyagi (Co-Founder & Vice President) (hereinafter referred to as "Second Party", company which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors – in-office, administrators and assigns).

(First Party and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as 'Parties' and individually as 'Party')

WHEREAS:

A) First Party is a Higher Educational Institution named:

D) Both Parties, being legal entities Sanskriti Youth Foundation, the Second Party, is a youth-led non-profit organization actively working in the field of environmental protection, climate action, river cleanup drives, sustainability initiatives, youth engagement, social impact campaigns, and community outreach programs across India.

E) Sanskriti Youth Foundation specializes in organizing environmental awareness campaigns, cleanup drives, sustainability initiatives, volunteer engagement activities, youth empowerment programs, climate action projects, and community-based social impact activities.

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERETO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

CLAUSE 1 CO-OPERATION

- 1.1 Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the Institution and its related wings. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.
- 1.2 First Party and Second Party co-operation will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the faculty of First Party providing significant inputs to them in developing suitable teaching / training systems, keeping in mind the needs of the industry, the Second Party.
- 1.3 The general terms of co-operation shall be governed by this MOU. The Parties shall cooperate with each other and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreements, deeds and documents (the 'Definitive Documents') as may be required to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MOU. The term of Definitive Documents shall be mutually decided between the Parties. Along with the Definitive Documents, this MOU shall represent the entire understanding as to the subject matter hereof and shall supersede any prior understanding between the Parties on the subject matter hereof.

CLAUSE 2: SCOPE OF THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)

- 2.1 The budding graduates from the institutions could play a key role in technological up-gradation, innovation and competitiveness of an industry. Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge.
- 2.2 Environmental Activities & Exposure Programs:** The First Party and Second Party shall collaborate in organizing environmental awareness campaigns, cleanup drives, plantation activities, sustainability initiatives, workshops, awareness rallies, volunteering activities, and social impact programs for students and faculty members. Students of the First Party may participate in programs conducted by Sanskriti Youth Foundation as volunteers, interns, or participants subject to institutional approval and participation guidelines.
- 2.3 Volunteering, Internship & Field Exposure Opportunities:** Second Party may provide opportunities for volunteering, social internships, field exposure, awareness campaign participation, event management experience, sustainability projects, and youth engagement activities subject to availability and organizational requirements.
- 2.4 Student Participation:** Students participating in activities under this MoU shall do so voluntarily for educational, environmental, social impact, and experiential learning purposes.
- 2.5 Curriculum Design:** Second Party may give valuable inputs to the First Party in teaching / training methodology and suitably customize the curriculum so that the students fit into the industrial scenario meaningfully.
- 2.6 Guest Lectures & Awareness Sessions:** Second Party shall extend necessary support for conducting guest lectures, awareness sessions, workshops, seminars, and interactive sessions related to environmental sustainability, climate action, youth leadership, social responsibility, and community engagement.
- 2.7 Skill Development Programs:** Second Party may train students of the First Party in leadership, volunteer management, environmental awareness, social responsibility, teamwork, communication, sustainability practices, and event coordination.
- 2.8 Faculty Development Programs:** Second Party to train the Faculties of First Party for imparting industrial exposure/ training as per the industrial requirement considering the National Occupational Standards in concerned sector, if available.
- 2.9 Management Development Programs:** First Party to train the member of Second Party to through Management Development programs abreast with the latest skills.
- 2.10 Research and Development:** Both Parties may jointly carry out research, surveys, awareness studies, environmental impact activities, community outreach initiatives, and sustainability-related projects beneficial for students and society.
- 2.11 Projects and Consultancy:** Both the parties agree to coordinate with each other on various projects and consultancy on various sectors of management.



2.12 Branding & Strengthen of Relations: Both the parties agree to use logo of each other for branding and strengthen of relations and can publicize on website and other social media. The students of Tecnia Institute of Advanced Studies undergoing internship with Stallion Capital Management Pvt. Ltd. may use the logo of the company on the report that would be submitted for final evaluation.

2.13 Branding & S trengthening of Relations: Both Parties may use each other's name and logo for collaboration announcements, awareness campaigns, reports, websites, social media, event publicity, and related educational purposes only after obtaining prior written consent from the respective party.

2.13A Media & Documentation: Both Parties may capture and share photographs, videos, activity reports, testimonials, and documentation related to joint activities for educational, awareness, and promotional purposes subject to mutual understanding and applicable privacy considerations.

2.13B Volunteer Participation Nature: Participation of students in activities conducted under this MoU shall be voluntary in nature and shall not create any employer-employee relationship between Sanskriti Youth Foundation and participating students.

2.13C Safety & Liability: Each party shall be responsible for ensuring safety, discipline, and conduct of its respective representatives and participants during activities conducted under this MoU. Sanskriti Youth Foundation shall not be held liable for any injury, accident, loss, or damage occurring during participation in voluntary activities except in cases of proven negligence.

2.13D Certificates & Recognition: Certificates of participation, volunteering, internship, appreciation, or training may be issued by Sanskriti Youth Foundation subject to participation criteria and completion of assigned responsibilities.

2.14 There is no financial commitment on the part of the Tecnia Institute of Advanced Studies, the First Party to take up any program mentioned in the MoU. If there is any financial consideration, it will be dealt separately.


CLAUSE 3: INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

3.1 Nothing contained in this MOU shall, by express grant, implication, Estoppel or otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copy rights and designs) of the other Party.

CLAUSE 4: VALIDITY

This Agreement shall remain valid for a period of One (1) Year from the date of signing and may be renewed upon mutual written consent of both Parties unless terminated earlier by either Party as per the terms of this MoU.

4.1 Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of Termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations

CLAUSE 5: RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES


- 5.1 It is expressly agreed that First Party, **M/s Tecnia Institute of Advanced Studies** and Second Party, **Sanskrit Youth Foundation**, are acting under this MOU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MOU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in any way, to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MOU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.

CLAUSE 6: ARBITRATION

- 6.1 Any divergence or difference derived from the interpretation or application of the MOU shall be resolved by arbitration between the parties as per the Arbitration Act, 1996. The place of the arbitration shall be at District Head Quarters of the First Party. This undertaking is to be construed in accordance with Indian Law with exclusive jurisdiction in the Courts of Delhi only.
