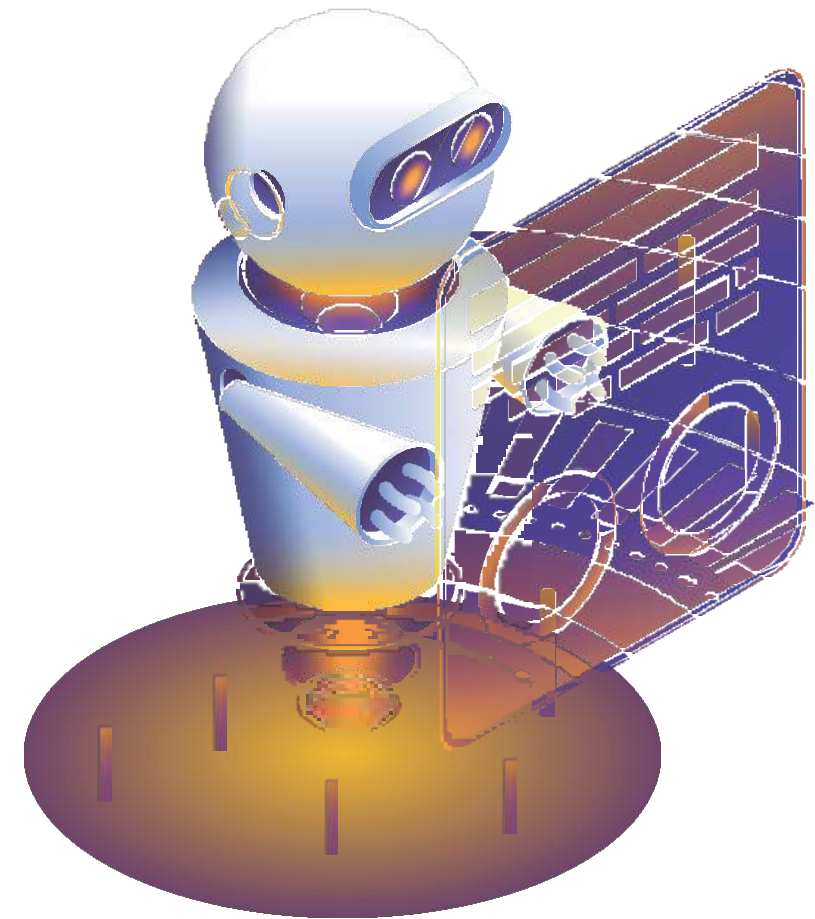

Rules and Regulations for the Events:-

TECHNOVISION 2026

1. Mystery Map (Treasure Hunt)

- Team participation only. No solo entries.
- Team members cannot be changed after registration.
- Mobile phones and outside help are not allowed.
- Only qualified teams receive the next clue.
- Every round has a time limit.
- Misbehavior, copying, or interference leads to disqualification.
- Judges' decision will be final.

2. Tech Pitch Event

- Individual or team participation (1–2 members).
- One project idea per team only.
- Ideas must be original and innovative.
- Presentation time: 5–7 minutes + Q&A.
- PPT/model/prototype allowed.
- Plagiarism leads to disqualification.
- Judges' decision final.

3. IoT Model Exhibition

- Individual or team participation allowed.
- Working model is compulsory.
- Bring required hardware/software components.
- Presentation with demo allowed.
- Projects must be IoT-based and original.
- Unsafe models are prohibited.
- Judges' decision final.

4. HACKSHIELD (Cybersecurity Challenge)

- Solo or team of 2–3 members.
- No unfair means or answer sharing.
- Only allowed tools/resources may be used.
- Complete tasks within event time.
- Misconduct leads to disqualification.
- Maintain discipline throughout event.

5. AI Poster Making

- Solo participation only.
- Poster must be created using AI tools.
- Themes will be revealed on event day.
- Time limit: 1 hour.
- Submit in JPEG/PNG format.
- Plagiarism not allowed.
- Judges' decision final.

6. SHE CREATES

- Girls-only team event (3–4 members).
- Individual participation also allowed.
- Follow round-wise instructions.
- Bring own materials for Rangoli round.
- Maintain discipline and teamwork.
- Copied work leads to disqualification.

7. DATA DETECTIVE

- Individual or team participation as announced.
- Solve clues, puzzles, and analytical tasks.
- Follow event instructions carefully.
- Use logic and teamwork fairly.
- No cheating or outside help.
- Final decision by organizers.

8. BGMI Tournament

- Squad of 4 players only.
- One player can join one team only.
- No hacks, cheats, emulators, or GFX tools.
- Late joining not allowed.
- Own internet and power bank required.
- Toxic behavior leads to disqualification.
- Organizers' decision final.

9. SQL Query Quest

- Individual participation only.
- Only SELECT queries allowed.
- No INSERT, UPDATE, DELETE, DROP queries.
- Use provided system/database only.
- No answer sharing or cheating.
- Ranking based on score + time.
- Organizers' decision final.



10. Code Storm

- Individual participation only.
- Solve coding problems within given time.
- Use allowed programming languages only.
- No copying or external help.
- Correct output and logic matter.
- Tie based on time and score.
